She is the author of several novels and short story collections including, **The Accidental, Hotel World, How to Be Both** and the Seasonal Quartet. She has been four times shortlisted for the Booker Prize, has won the Goldsmiths Prize, Orwell Prize, Costa Best Novel Award, The Austrian State Prize for European Literature, the Bodley Medal, and the Women's Prize. Her novel **Autumn** was one of the New York Times 10 Best Books of 2017, and this year the same newspaper selected her novel How to be Both as one of the 100 Best Books of the 21st century.
