

## Join our Youth Board and have your say!

People under 30 make up almost 40% of our population, but they are less than 1% of members on decision-making boards across the country.

Our Youth Board is a dedicated group of people aged 18-30 who are interested in arts leadership. Youth Board members meet regularly with Park Theatre's senior team, to hear about the theatre's activities and development plans and to feed into discussions which move us forward in our ambitions.

### What's in it for me?

- **Boost professional development** through an understanding of leadership and charity governance
- **Have your voice heard** as part of senior leadership discussions at the theatre
- **Deepen your understanding** of leadership within the arts
- **Meet likeminded people** with similar interest in arts governance

No prior experience is needed to apply to sit on the Youth Board.

### What is the commitment?

Members are expected to attend four, two-hour meetings per year. In addition, members are expected to see Park Theatre productions when possible.

Members are invited to join the Youth Board for a minimum of 2 years, with possibility to extend.
