Dave is a playwright and screenwriter. He recently adapted his Hampstead Theatre play Experience into the feature film Embers, which was nominated for Best UK Feature at Raindance Film Festival. His play Somewhere Beneath won a Fringe First at the Edinburgh Festival, and his short plays have been produced at the Royal Court, Soho Theatre and the Criterion Theatre. Other credits include: Afterbirth (Arcola), A Serious Business (Luton Hat Factory/ Pleasance), Hand Over Fist (Edinburgh Festival), the BBC Radio 4 comedy Shock Jock, and feature thriller Sins in the Family premiered on Lifetime/ Paramount+.

Known as the 'King of Improvised Chaos' and a regular collaborator with Mischief Theatre, Adam is the director of the Olivier Award-nominated worldwide smash-hit Peter Pan Goes Wrong (including Broadway, UK tour, New Zealand/ Australia, West End) and Magic Goes Wrong (UK tour, West End), and the co-creator and artistic director of Olivier Award-winning Showstoppers! The Improvised Musical. Showstoppers has played in twelve countries worldwide and continues a West End residency.

Adam's current production Peter Pan Goes Wrong on Broadway has been nominated for three Drama Desk Awards, three Outer Critics Circle Awards and a Drama League Award for Outstanding Production.
