Sami Abu Wardeh – ‘*Full of charm*’ Chortle – is a Palestinian-British performer blending clowning, comedy, and political storytelling to explore identity and resistance. His work is layered, intelligent, and thought-provoking while also being approachable and, typically, very, very silly. He is a leading voice of the Palestinian diaspora in the arts and comedy.

As an artist, his shows are a blend of comedy, theatre, and clown. His hit live show, *BEDU*, received critical acclaim and was one of The Guardian’s Top 10 Shows of 2022. He went on to create and star in the Channel 4 series *The Sheikh*. He is a playwright whose work has been staged at the Arcola Theatre as part of Cutting the Tightrope and he has written and featured on BBC Radio 4, inc Damned Andrew and The Jaffa Cherry Orchard, and he’s regularly featured for The Guardian’s Long Read podcast.
