



Company Stage Manager

Park Theatre is recruiting a Company Stage Manager for our upcoming immersive fundraising theatre production, *Whodunnit [Unrehearsed] 4*.

Whodunnit [Unrehearsed] 4 is a comedy murder mystery, where a different celebrity takes to the stage each performance to try and solve the murder. They've never seen the script before and are fed all of their lines via an earpiece. The 2026 edition marks the most ambitious version yet. For the first time, the production will take over the entire building, from the street outside to the bars, foyers and both auditoria. The exterior will be reimagined as a Western streetscape, while interior spaces will be dressed with saloon-style décor.

This show is a key fundraiser for Park Theatre, which receives no regular public subsidy. Proceeds support the running of the venue, new writing and community programmes.

The Company Stage Manager will oversee stage management across the production. They will work with the Director and Production Manager to ensure the smooth, safe operation of the production, acting as the key liaison between the cast, creative team, producers, and venue staff.

Main Responsibilities:

- Act as an authoritative, compassionate and reliable senior manager for a large company of actors, stage managers, musicians and community performers, taking responsibility for the effective running of rehearsals and performances.
- Line Manage the Deputy Stage Manager and Assistant Stage Manager
- Working with the Director to plan schedules for rehearsals, technical rehearsals, and dress rehearsals, and disseminate calls to the company
- Manage and keep time within the rehearsal room to ensure all breaks are taken in line with relevant union agreements and any missed breaks are recorded
- Monitor and control overtime as required and take responsibility for the processing timesheets for the cast and stage management team
- Provide effective management and excellent pastoral care to the cast and stage management team during the rehearsal and running periods of the Production
- Represent the company with diplomacy, discretion, and courtesy at all times, safeguarding confidential information

- Act as a senior point of contact for the company, liaising with producers and relevant venue staff on all matters
- Pick up stage management tracks during absences or at moments in the performance where extra assistance is required.
- Act as an occasional point of contact backstage for the guest celebrity sheriffs

- Significant experience as a Company Stage Manager on productions of a similar scale.
- Experience working with a combination of professional and community performers
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to manage creative individuals
- Excellent organisational and administrative skills
- Ability to act with tact and discretion when working with high profile individuals

- Experience working on productions that include an immersive Front of House experience
- Experience of improv theatre or productions that are different every night
