All the information in this document is subject to change based on what events are currently on in Park 90. Depending on staging, setup and configuration, there may be some restrictions or considerations that must be discussed with the relevant team in Park Theatre.

A site visit is mandatory for all hires - please liaise with the **Venue Technician/ Deputy General Manager** to arrange a date and time.

There is very limited storage space on site. Should your event require pre-emptive storage, please contact Park Technical Team directly.

Any event waste must be taken away by the company.

The Space

The space size is dependent on the configuration of the current show and any set they might have.

The average playing space is approx. 5m x 4m.

Lighting

Lighting Desk: **ETC ION Classic**

There will always be access to a general wash & House lights fader. These are made using the current in-house shows rig and as such, subject to their focus.

Any external equipment hired or owned by the visiting company must be PAT tested prior to use at Park Theatre and related paperwork must be provided.

Sound

Sound Desk: Yamaha MG16XU (subject to availability).

There will typically be at least 2 speakers in the grid focused towards the seating banks. For specific playback or microphone needs please contact the technical team.

Other Sound Information

A mini-Jack input could be set up for playback. Wired and Wireless Mics can also be made available (subject to availability), prices available on request.

If you wish to use any other supplementary types of sound equipment such as monitors, not detailed in this spec, please contact the technical team directly.

Any externally sourced radio equipment used on Park Theatre premises must not infringe on frequencies used in house and/or other visiting companies and must be licenced. Park Theatre reserves the right to instruct visiting companies to control the frequencies of radio equipment should any issues arise. Please feel free to contact Park Technical for details of current frequencies used.

Power Distribution

13A General local power outlets are located on the Gantry level and in the backstage area. Extension leads may be available upon request.

Set and Stage

The Hire will be on top of the current running show, so please bear in mind that there will be limitations to what can be achieved. Please contact Park Technical Department directly and we can advise for more information. For example, Lino might need to be rolled out to protect the floor.

Dressing Rooms

Backstage Washroom Facilities

Two unisex toilets, one of which is accessible, plus two unisex showers.

Laundry

There is a communal laundry room with a washing machine and tumble dryer backstage. This is for the use of all companies.

General Information

The space has air conditioning and skylight windows, which can be controlled on request. Show relays (switchable between our two spaces) feed to the BOH areas.

Access/Parking

Get-in access is through the front doors of Park Theatre on Clifton Terrace.

Park Theatre cannot offer any parking. On Sundays the parking restrictions outside the theatre are exempt. However, as we are located close to Arsenal Football stadium, full parking restrictions are in place (even on a Sunday) when there is an Arsenal home match.

Items coming into Park90 must comfortably fit through a doorway measuring **W1004mm x H2040mm**.

There is a small passenger lift that can be used to transport larger items from street level to corridor. The lift has a maximum weight capacity of 630kg. Any damage caused to the lift will be charged to the event.

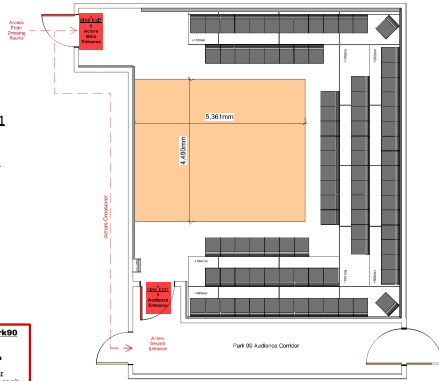

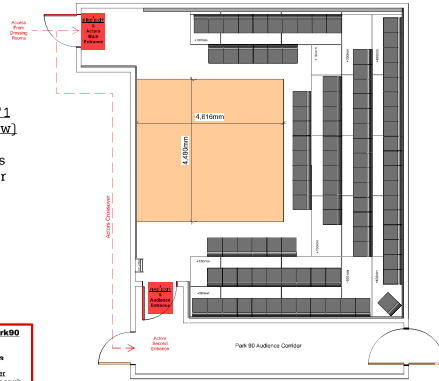
